

CRIBBAGE TOURNAMENT HOUSE RULES

This tournament is for people who are very familiar with the rules of cribbage and will be played as individuals. Initial rounds will be played to 61 points or a maximum of 20 minutes. Knockout Round, Semi-Finals and Finals will be played to 121 points or a maximum of 35 minutes.

We ask attendees to please bring your own board if you have one!

1. Round Robin groups are determined at random by computer draw. There will be 6 groups of 6. Group selection is final. **We are unable to accommodate group selection requests.**
2. Tournaments will be played Round Robin style between your selected group members. All members of the group will play each other 1 time.
3. Round Robin games will be played to 61 or a maximum of 20 minutes.
4. Individuals in groups will be responsible for selecting their opponents as well as whose cribbage board you play on. You must play each person in your group 1 time. Next rounds can begin as soon as a player you need to play is available. You do not need to wait for the official start of the round, however end game times MUST adhere to the 20 minutes per round rule.
5. We will be following the [Bicycle Card Game Rules](#). Please review prior to play as we will not have anyone managing the rules of the game, this shall be self regulated between those playing. Please note that these rules **do** include Muggins. Individuals will be in charge of filling out the scoresheet provided. There will be no additional help with scoring, this must be done between the two players.
6. Scoring will be as following
 - Skunk = 2 points
 - Win = 1 point
 - Loss = 0 pointThe team with the most points from Skunk/Win/Loss will win. If there is a tie, the team with the most total scored points will win. Top place teams for each group will move to the knockout round. The top scorer of the knockout round will receive a bye for Semi-Finals. The winner of the Semi-Finals will play in the Finals. There will be a grand prize for the first place winner, and a secondary prize for second place.
7. In the event of uneven teams/no shows, we will do our best to ensure everyone gets to play all rounds. However, there may be instances where a BYE round is granted. If a player receives a BYE round they will automatically be granted 61 points and a WIN (1 point) on their scoresheet.
