## YAHTZEE TOURNAMENT HOUSE RULES

This tournament is for people who are familiar with the rules of Yahtzee and will be played as individuals. Those competing will play three rounds of creative Yahtzee mini games and a final round of traditional Yahtzee!

Dice. Scorecards and Mats Provided.

- 1. Table seating will be first come first served. Come solo or with friends. Yahtzee games will be played in groups of 3 or 4.
- 2. To decide who goes first, each player in turn rolls all five dice. The player with the highest total goes first. Play then passes to the left.
- 3. Individuals are responsible for their own scorekeeping.
- 4. The first three rounds of the tournament will consist of the following Yahtzee mini games:
  - Round One Upper Section Only
    6 turns of max 3 rolls to fill out the Yahtzee scorecard's upper section. Go for 63!
  - Round Two Bottom Section Only
    7 turns of max 3 rolls to fill out the Yahtzee scorecard's lower section. Go for YHATZEE!
  - Round Three Extra Dice
    Roll 6 dice instead of 5! 8 turns of max 3 rolls. Pick your best five dice at the end of each turn to strategically fill in your scorecard across both sections to maximize your final score.

Each Mini Game Round will be a maximum of 25 minutes. If the game is not complete by that point, calculate your scores as is when the timer goes off.

- 5. The fourth and final round will be a traditional game of Yahtzee. Please review the official <u>Yahtzee</u> <u>Instructions</u> prior to play as we will not have anyone managing the rules of the game, this shall be self regulated between those playing. This round will end once each player has completed their scorecard.
- 6. There will be prizes for the highest scores of each three mini games. The Grand Prize winner will be determined by the highest cumulative score across all four rounds. If a tie breaker is needed, players will roll five dice and the player with the highest total wins!
